



PLEASE NOTE AMENDMENTS (in bold)

Any **club, player or club member** may appeal to this Association against the decision of an affiliated body affecting the club, or a member of the club with the exception of a suspension imposed in accordance with the fixed penalties incorporated in Rule 42. Such appeals to be lodged by recorded or registered delivery and in duplicate within seven days of receipt of notice of the decision of the affiliated body and accompanied by a deposit of **£50** incl. VAT. This deposit may be forfeited if the Association so decides. The grounds of appeal must be specifically stated and if the **Association considers the appeal frivolous or trivial, the appellant may be liable to a levy of up to a sum of money, which shall be fixed annually by the Appeals Committee.** All affiliated bodies must incorporate in their rules a clause specifying the right of its members to appeal to this Association, and the decision of this Association must be given effect to by the affiliated body. The decision against which any appeal is made will only be set aside when the appeal is received by the Association and agreed to be in order and confirmation is received in writing by the parties concerned.
